

Donation Campaign

- Following the outbreak of war, the Ministry of Energy of Ukraine (MinEnergo) submitted a request for assistance to BMWE.
- BMWE launched the donation and procurement campaign in spring 2022 (procurement campaign was finalized in February 2025).
- The campaign is implemented through GIZ as part of the project "Power4Just Transition" under the umbrella of the German-Ukrainian Energy Partnership.
- Objective: To support the reconstruction of the energy infrastructure by providing technical goods.





Donations from German Companies in September 2025

In September, 72 goods were delivered to their final beneficiaries.

The Düsseldorf municipal utilities donated four special vehicles. The donation includes a bucket truck for work at heights, two vans, and a specialized service vehicle, all of which are adapted for emergency repair crews.

Combined heat and power unit by Oberstein-Idarer Elektrizität AG

Oberstein-Idarer-Elektrizität AG has donated a combined heat and power plant to Ukraine. This plant can generate 50 kW of electricity and 80 kW of heat simultaneously. These CHP plants are very efficient because they convert excess heat.

Vehicles will help crews quickly deliver staff, tools, and spare parts to damaged sites, speeding up emergency response and restoring electricity to people more quickly.




Classification of delivered goods
